

MORAL

ETHICS

Ethics means conduct that is guided by virtue. Ethics is ethics. (พระเทวินทร์ เทวินโท, 2544)

Ethics says that if narrow interpretation, ethics Refers to one morality and another virtue combined as two things.(สุนทรโคตร บรรเทา,2544)

moral and ethical standards


What is regarded as the principle of determining the state of virtue and codes of conduct or morals that corresponds to the correctness of the organization.
